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Fee Schedule

Daily hours 8:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. Monday to Friday

Berrigan Children's Centre is closed on National and New South Wales Public Holidays. The Christmas closure dates will be advised before the start of November 2026.

The following fees do not take into account Child Care Subsidy (CCS) that families may be eligible for.

Long Day Care (0 – 3 years)	\$142.00 daily fee
Long Day Care (3 – 5 years Preschool)	\$131.00 daily fee
Before School Care	\$15.00 per session (8:00 a.m. to (9:00 a.m.) NSW school terms.
After School Care	\$38.00 per session (3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.) NSW school terms
Vacation Care and pupil free days	\$142.00 daily fee (NSW School holidays, excluding annual Christmas closure)
Casual fees – 0 to 3 years	\$147.00 per day
Casual fees – 3 to 5 years	\$136.00 per day
Casual fees – After School Care	\$43.00 per session
Casual fees – Vacation Care	\$147.00 per day

Inclusions

- Morning tea
- Nappies
- Late afternoon tea – for children that are collected after 4:30 p.m. This is in addition to the earlier afternoon tea (supplied by families)

Holiday Rates

- If you would like to take holidays at any time during the year, we offer a discount of 50% off your daily fee for a limit of two weeks (pro-rata to the number of days your child attends) per child per financial year. These must be taken in week blocks (Monday to Friday) and will only be granted if your fees are up to date prior to your holiday commencing. Please be aware that these absences will count towards your annual total allowable absence that are funded by CCS
- Requests must be made via email to admin@bccca.org.au or the Xplor app at least 10 business days before the planned absence.
- The discounted holiday rate cannot be used for sessions of care that fall on a public holiday.
- Unused discounted holiday rates cannot be used in the new financial year (no carryover) or transferred to another child.

The Child Care Subsidy (CCS) hourly rate caps and family income thresholds will go up from 6 July 2026.

The hourly rate caps and income thresholds are adjusted annually based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI).

The maximum hourly rate we subsidise is based on the type of care you provide. The 2026–27 hourly rate caps for each care type are outlined below.

Care type	Hourly rate cap for children below school age	Hourly rate cap for school-age children
Centre Based Day Care	\$15.19	\$13.30
Outside School Hours Care	\$15.19	\$13.30
Family Day Care	\$14.08	\$14.08
In Home Care (per family)	\$41.31	\$41.31

The family income thresholds have also changed according to the CPI, as outlined below:

Family income	Subsidy rate
Up to \$88,520	90%
More than \$88,520 to below \$538,520	Between 90% and 0% The percentage decreases by 1% for every \$5,000 of income a family earns
\$538,520 or more	0%

A family's CCS subsidy rate is the percentage of the hourly rate the government will subsidise.

2026 NSW Start Strong Fee Relief

If your child is aged 3–5 and enrolled in a preschool program at our centre, you may also be eligible for **Start Strong Fee Relief**, a NSW Government initiative that provides:

- Up to \$769 per year for children aged 3 in long day care
- Up to \$2,563 per year for children aged 4 and above, attending a preschool program

If you haven't already provided your consent for us to claim this funding on your behalf, please speak with our administration team to ensure you're receiving the maximum benefit.
